Performance guaranty required:

- a. A corporate surety bond or certified check shall be presented with application for permit in the sum of \$30 per square foot of road surface to be cut.
- b. The corporate surety bond or certified check shall be retained by the Town for one year from the date of notification of completion of paving.
- c. At expiration of the one-year period, if the repaved area remains in a satisfactory condition, the corporate surety bond or certified check shall be returned to the applicant.
- d. If, during the one-year period, the repaved area requires correction or repair, as determined by the Superintendent of the Street Department, the contractor shall, upon notification, make the necessary corrections or repairs within 10 days thereof or forfeit corporate surety bond or certified check.
