- \$25.00 Male - Neuter & Rabies Vaccine (and eartip if feral)
- \$40.00 Female - Spay & Rabies Vaccine (and eartip if feral)
- Rabies Vaccine is mandatory unless proof of such can be presented by owner/caretaker. Eartipping is also mandatory on **feral cats**.
- \$15.00 extra - Male - Undescended testicle fee

### **Extras**

- \$25.00 Additional combo testing for feline Aids/Leukemia
- \$5.00 Distemper Vaccine
- \$5.00 Nail trim
- \$15.00 Topical application for fleas
- \$5.00 Topical application fee on ferals **IF** you bring your own (\$15.00 if not)

No dogs at this event. No walk-ins - you must be pre-registered.
