1. TAP Grant
 - a. Change in parking spaces on Main
 - i. We have 100 existing parking spaces and 11 of them do not meet Title 39, so you effectively have 89 “legal” parking spaces. In the proposed condition, we will provide 95 legal parking spaces which conform with Title 39. See attached emails at memo from planning engineer
