Herb Goldenberg

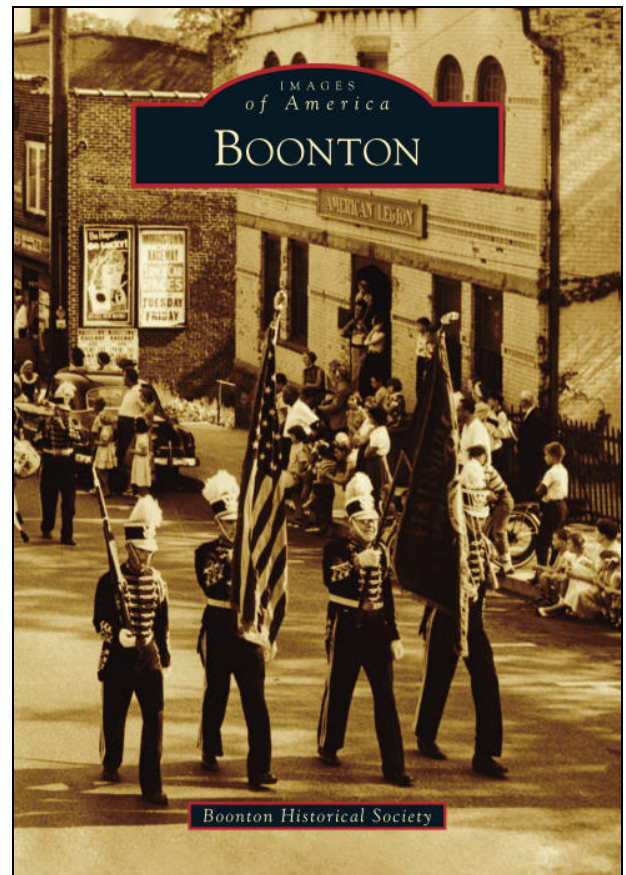
