Over 200 classic and custom cars will be on display along Main Street bringing automobiles and spectators from all over the Tri-state area.

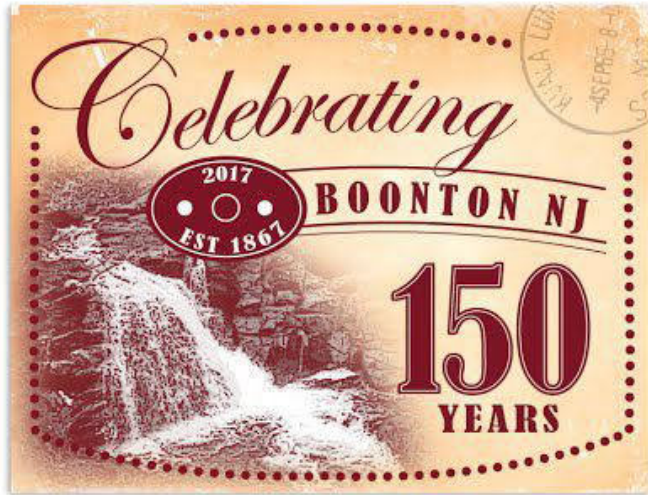
## BOONTON DAY

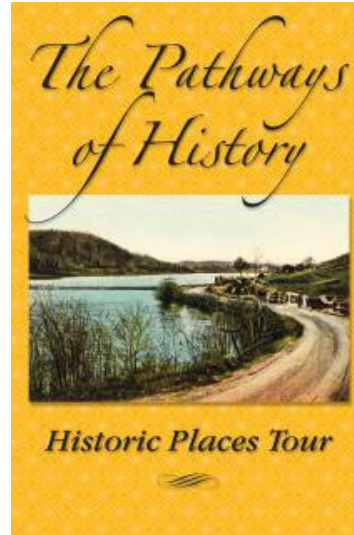

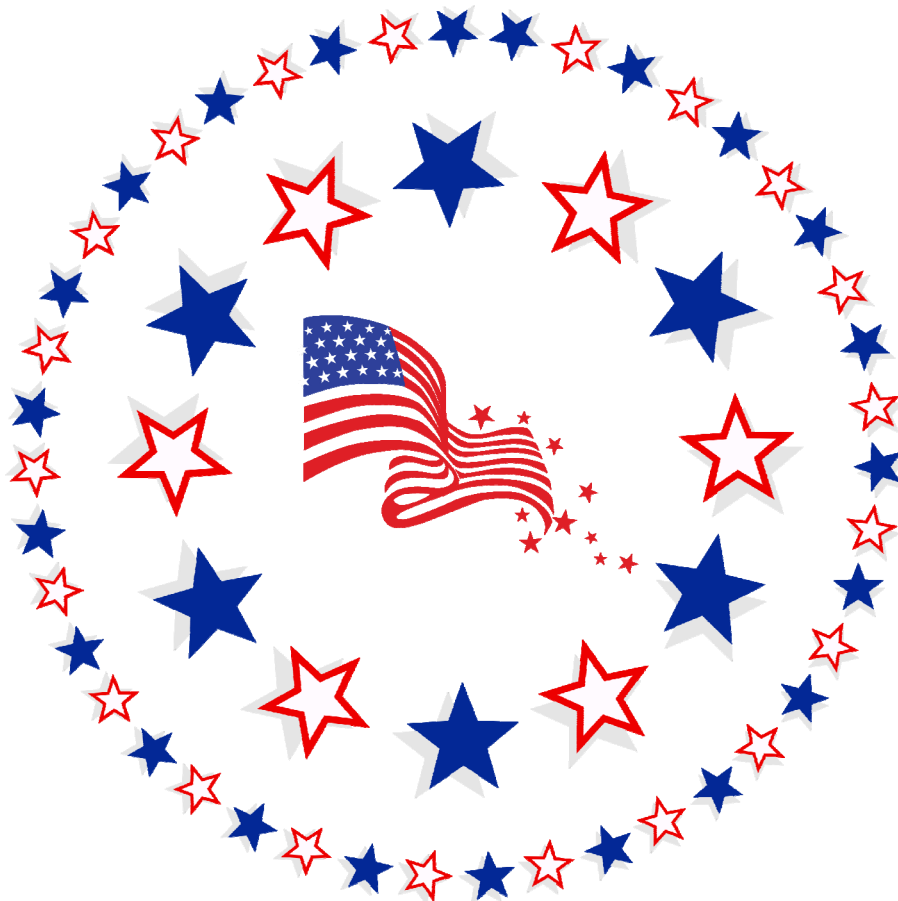
