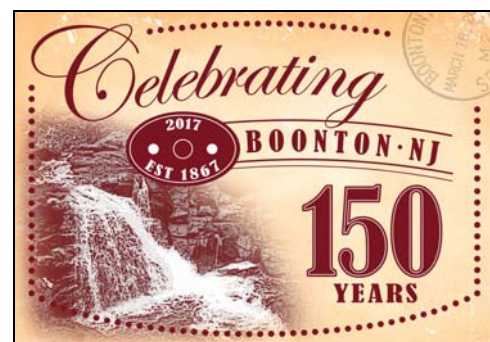
Celebrating Boonton, NJ: 150 Years

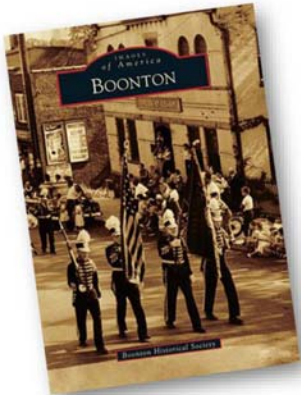
