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**RESOLUTION 20-281**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO AMEND REMOTE MEETING PROCEDURES APPLICABLE DURING A DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, on November 2, 2020, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen adopted Resolution 20-264, which established remote meeting procedures during a Governor-declared state of emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Open Public Meetings Act permits public entities to establish a reasonable time limit for public comments during public meetings; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town wishes to amend Resolution 20-264 to change the time limit for public comment from five (5) minutes to three (3) minutes for both spoken and written public comments, to allow more individuals to be heard.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Boonton, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, does hereby resolve and agree to amend Resolution 20-264 to establish a three (3) minute limit on spoken and written public comments made or read during public meetings.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
