RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT TO VENDOR WITH NEW JERSEY STATE COOPERATIVE CONTRACTS FOR BOONTON FIRE DEPARTMENT CHIEF'S CAR/INCIDENT COMMAND CENTER

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Boonton, Morris County, State of New Jersey, as follows:

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of the Local Public Contract Law P.L. 2011, C.139 (the "Law" or "Chapter 139" and N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2 the regulations promulgated thereunder in Local Finance Notice LFN 2012-10, the following purchase without competitive bids from vendor with a New Jersey State Cooperative Contract is hereby approved for municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the Chief's Car/Incident Command Center, through Gentinlini/Upfitme - Government Vehicles Contract Number #47-CPCPS 2021 CRAN is \$48,490.14; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the Town of Boonton has certified that adequate funds for such contract are available and are designated to line item appropriation of the official budget. A copy of the said certification is attached hereto and part hereof and the funds to be expended herein are assigned to line item no. (see below). A copy of the within resolution and certification shall be certified by the Town Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Town Administrator is satisfied that the availability of funds has been provided and a copy of the within resolution shall be made a part of the file concerning said resolution and appointment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Business Administrator is hereby directed to effectuate the purchase of herein approved equipment for the approved cost, not to exceed \$48,490.14.
