**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON SETTING THE ANNUAL SALARY OF EMPLOYEE TRAVIS KNOEDLER WHILE ATTENDING THE MORRIS COUNTY POLICE ACADEMY**

**WHEREAS**, Town of Boonton Employee Travis Knoedler (hereinafter "employee") currently serves as the Town's Parking Enforcement Officer, at an annual salary of \$49,773.00 per year; and

**WHEREAS**, such employee has been accepted to attend the Morris County Public Safety Training Academy; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the current Collective Bargaining Agreement entered into between the Town of Boonton and the New Jersey State Policemen's Benevolent Association, Boonton Local #212 (hereinafter, the "CBA"), the Academy Step salary the employee would receive would be significantly less than the employee's current salary; and

**WHEREAS**, the governing body wishes to encourage, and not diminish, the matriculation of Town of Boonton Police Officers from within the Town's employees; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey State Policemen's Benevolent Association, Boonton Local #212 does not object to having this employee's salary maintained at its current level, notwithstanding the Academy Step salary as noted within the CBA.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Boonton, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1) Effective July 5, 2021, employee Travis Knoedler shall receive a salary of \$51,877.00 per annum while he is in training at the Morris County Public Safety Training Academy.
- 2) This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
