At the November 15th meeting of the Mayor and Town Council, it was announced the Boonton Kiwanis First Aid Squad will cease operations effective November 15th at 11:59pm. The Mayor and Town Council want to assure the residents and visitors of Boonton ambulance services will continue to be provided to the Town of Boonton without interruption. Basic Life Support (BLS) services will continue to be provided by Saint Clare's Health System between the hours of 6am and 6pm Monday-Friday. Morris County Office of Emergency Management/Emergency Medical Services (EMS) will provide BLS services 6pm-6am Monday-Friday, and provide 24-hour coverage on Saturday and Sunday. Morris County EMS provides a state licensed ambulance staffed with two NJ certified Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs). Morris County EMS bills for their services and accepts the payment from patients' insurance companies as payment in full; they do not bill patients for any unpaid balance that is not covered by insurance. If a patient does not have insurance, they will not receive a bill from Morris County EMS.

The Mayor, Town Council, and town administration will continue to work with all involved parties to solidify a plan for 2022 for basic life support services for the Town of Boonton.
