**RESOLUTION 22-187**

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF BOONTON, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION FROM THE NJ DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR APPARATUS AND TURN OUT GEAR FOR THE BOONTON FIRE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Boonton desires to apply for and obtain a grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs for approximately \$74,980 to carry out a project to purchase four (4) Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA), eight (8) sets of turn-out gear and thirty-one (31) SCBA facepieces. The purchased protective clothing (turnout clothing ensembles) will instantly affect not only the Fire Department but the mutual aid cities of the Morris County and its citizens. The award allows us the basic PPE needed to perform all the services rendered by a suburban fire department, including COVID-19, which responds to every type of emergency and to deliver these services in a manner which is not only safer for the firefighter but also allows the services to be implemented more efficiently and in a safer manner.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town of Boonton does hereby authorize the application for such a grant, with no anticipated match of funds required at this time; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Town recognizes and accepts that the Department may offer a lesser or greater amount and therefore, upon receipt of the grant agreement from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, does further authorize the execution of any such grant agreement; and also, upon receipt of the fully executed agreement from the Department, does further authorize the expenditure of funds pursuant to the terms of the agreement between the Town of Boonton and the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Town Administrator and Town Clerk be and are hereby authorized to sign the application, and any other documents necessary in connection therewith
