**RESOLUTION 22-234**

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY  
AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN ADDENDUM TO AN AGREEMENT WITH PROCHAMPS AS TO  
VACANT AND ABANDONED PROPERTIES IN THE TOWN OF BOONTON**

**WHEREAS**, An Agreement was made between the Town of Boonton and Pro Champs on May 17, 2021 (the Agreement”) as to Town Ordinance No. 05-21, entitled “Registration of Foreclosing Mortgaged Property and Vacant Property”; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Jersey enacted Chapter 444 on January 18th, 2022, requiring full remittance of fees to the participating municipalities and for the vendor to supply invoices for payment of services pertaining to property registration: and

**WHEREAS**, the remittance requirement is to be instituted and effective for all payments after August 1, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Town Ordinance No. 05-21, the Town of Boonton desires to enter into an Addendum to the Agreement, in order to amend services authorized pursuant to the Ordinance and New Jersey Chapter 444, so that PROCHAMPS can properly remit payments and supply the Town with invoices.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Boonton, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That the appropriate municipal officials are hereby authorized to execute an Addendum to the Agreement between the Town of Boonton and PROCHAMPS of May 17, 2022.
2. The appropriate municipal officials and employees and the Town attorney are hereby further authorized and directed to take any actions as necessary to further the intent and purpose of the Agreement and such Addendum.
3. This Resolution and the above referenced Addendum and Agreement shall be available for public inspection in the office of the Town Clerk.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
